


James: New life is for new living


"Do not merely listen to the word... Do what it says." (James 1:22)

Aim of the series


... to encourage and equip us to live more and more in the good of what we believe.






James: in the world but not of the world



- "Listen, my dear brothers and sisters: has not God chosen those who are poor in the eyes of the **world** to be rich in faith and to inherit the kingdom he promised those who love him?" (James 2:5)
- "You adulterous people, don't you know that friendship with the world means enmity against God? Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God." (James 4:4)




- "You are the salt of the earth...You are the light of the world..." (Matthew 5:13-16)
- "(Jesus) said to them, 'Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation'". (Mark 16:15)
- "Anyone who loves their life will lose it, while anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for eternal life." (John 12:25)
- "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world." (John 15:18&19a)
- "I have told you these things (what would happen after Jesus' death), so that in me you may have peace. In this **world** you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the **world**." (John 16:33)

Jesus: <u>in</u> the world but not <u>of</u> the world



"I will remain in the **world** no longer, but they are still in the **world**, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one.

I have given them your word and the **world** has hated them, for they are **not** of the **world** any more than I am of the **world**. My prayer is not that you take them out of the **world** but that you protect them from the evil one. They are not of the **world**, even as I am not of it. As you sent me into the **world**, I have sent them into the **world**... that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the **world** may believe that you have sent me. I in them and you in me – so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the **world** will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me." (John 17:14-18,21&23)





YOther NT: <u>in</u> the world but not <u>of</u> the world


 "Now ... our conscience testifies that we have conducted ourselves in the world, and especially in our relations with you, with integrity and godly sincerity. We have done so, relying not on

worldly wisdom but on God's grace." (2 Corinthians 1:12)



Purpose and perspective






"Those who live according to the **flesh** have their minds set on what the **flesh** desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their <u>minds set on</u> <u>what the Spirit desires</u>... Those who are in the realm of the **flesh** cannot please God." (Romans 8:5&8)

"So I say, <u>live by the Spirit</u>, and you will not gratify the desires of the **fles**h. For the **flesh** desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the **flesh**. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want...Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the **flesh** with its passions and desires. Since we <u>live by the Spirit</u>, let us <u>keep in step with the Spirit</u>." (Galatians 5:16&17, 24&25)
